Science Revision – Autumn examinations

Form 8

CE candidates will sit three papers — biology, chemistry and physics. These will cover all 13+ content covered during Forms 6, 7 and the first part of Form 8. There are two levels of paper — 1 and 2. Pupils will sit a paper relevant to their own level. The content covered at each level is the same, although the style of questions will vary slightly by level. The ISEB revision guide has information on this. In class the pupils are given lots of practice sitting these papers. Calculators are allowed in all papers.

Scholarship candidates will sit appropriate scholarship papers and will have had practice working through these papers before the examination.

Form 7

In Form 7, pupils will sit only 1 paper. This will be made up of CE 13+ content covered during Form 6 and the first part of Form 7. A checklist of topics will be provided to pupils in advance of the examinations. It is likely that a small amount of revision will be done in class for these examinations, although the onus is on students to support this with revision at home. Calculators are allowed to be used.

Form 6

In Form 6, pupils will sit only 1 paper. This paper tests work that has been covered in the Autumn Term. It is likely that a small amount of revision will be done in class for these examinations, although the onus is on students to support this with revision at home. Calculators are allowed to be used.

Pupils will require calculators for all science papers. We recommend the use of the Casio scientific calculators which will also be required for maths exams.
