	<b>ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS</b> You and Your Environment: Electricity To understand the environmental impact of electricity and how behaviour can help to reduce it	<ul> <li>Discuss why one should care for the environment</li> <li>Discuss impact of electricity and how to reduce usage</li> <li>Brainstorm ways to save on electricity at school – turning off lights, switching off monitors etc</li> <li>Produce posters in pairs to be displayed in the classroom and around school to encourage/remind people to do their bit</li> </ul>	Generating electricity has a number of different effects on environments: Power plants used to make it often use fossil fuels (non- renewable), produce "greenhouse gases", pollute the ecosystem when discarding waste products

Is there anything you can do when you're old that you can't do as a younger person?</li> <li>YouTube clip (bratty child).
