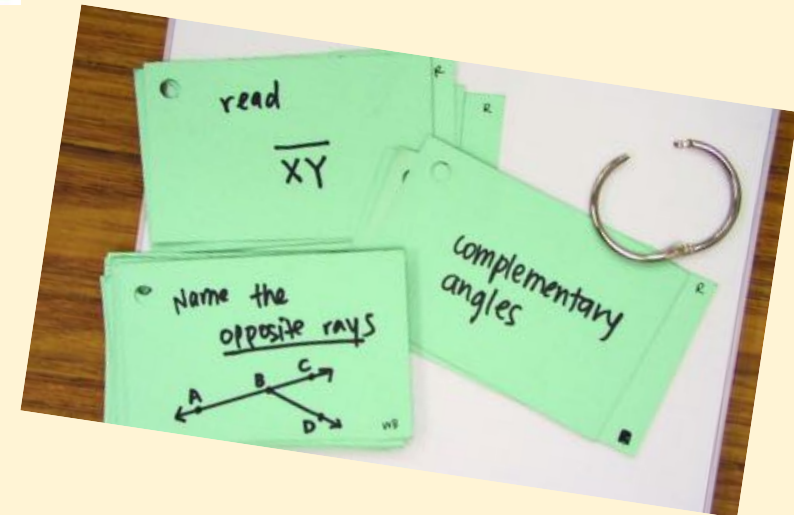
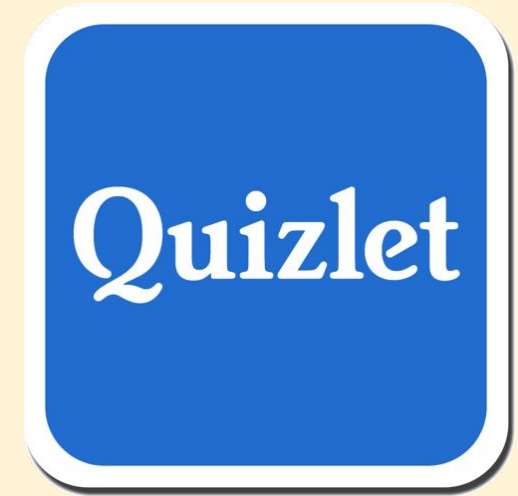
- Subject sections.
